Tea Party Organizer: *founding member of Burleson Tea Party [2009-2010], Hood County Tea Party [March 2011] and the Texas Patriots Tea Party. The Burleson Tea Party issued the “Burleson Declaration” with a list of our grievances that was read into the U.S. House of Representatives record on July 23, 2009. He was a Director, VP, President and/or Webmaster of the Texas Patriots Tea Party for almost 10 years [2010-2019]. Our tea party successfully sued the IRS for viewpoint discrimination. Dr. Schleich was the tea party’s key correspondent with our attorneys for over 4 years [2015-2019]. The IRS deposed Dr Schleich twice. As one of 5 named plaintiffs, the Texas Patriots Tea Party received about \$24,322 of the \$3.5 million settlement as our part of the settlement for violating our group’s civil rights and targeting us for our conservative viewpoints.*

Advocate for an Article V Convention of States [2013-2024] *since the summer of 2013 after Mark Levin published “The Liberty Amendments” in 2012 and Mark Meckler and the Citizens for Self-Governance started Convention of States Action.*

- *Dr Schleich gave 20 presentations to civic, tea party and high school groups on an Article V COS.*
- *In 2015-2016, as an RPT delegate, Dr Schleich testified on a COS before the platform committee and TX Sen Joan Huffman’s Senate State Affairs Committee.*
- *In 2016, Governor Greg Abbott recognized COS supporters at the Governor’s Mansion.*
- *Finally, the 85th Texas Legislature passed a COS Resolution and called for an Article V Convention of States on May 4, 2017. Texas became the 11th state to do so.:*
